Objectives	<p>Candidates should achieve the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Understand the role of the first-aider, including reference to: • the importance of preventing cross infection • the need for recording incidents and actions • use of available equipment • Assess the situation and circumstances in order to act safely, promptly and effectively in an emergency • Administer first aid to a casualty who is unconscious (including seizure) • Administer cardiopulmonary resuscitation • Administer first aid to a casualty who is choking • Administer first aid to a casualty who is wounded and bleeding • Administer first aid to a casualty who is suffering from shock • Provide appropriate first aid for minor injuries (including small cuts, grazes and bruises, minor burns and scalds, small splinters). • Administer first aid to a casualty with • injuries to bones, muscles and joints, including suspected spinal injuries • chest injuries • burns and scalds • eye injuries • sudden poisoning • anaphylactic shock • Recognise the presence of major illness (including heart attack, stroke, epilepsy, asthma, diabetes) and provide appropriate first aid. <p>+ Forestry Modules</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Getting help in remote locations • Catastrophic bleeding • Suspension Trauma • Crush Injury • High Pressure Hose injury • Lyme Disease • Emergency Blood-clotting agents • Amputation
