Objectives	<p>Candidates should achieve the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Identify key aspects of pesticide legislation relating to stem injection • Assess the environmental factors relating to the injection site • Read and interpret a product label • Identify product safety requirements • Select appropriate personal protective equipment • Understand the correct procedures for storing pesticides and the safe disposal of empty containers, surplus pesticide and washings • Follow appropriate personal hygiene procedures • Deal with accidental contamination • Understand where pesticide application may pose a risk to people and the environment • Understand the keeping of records • Prepare stem injection equipment for work, calibrate and operate to ensure accurate application without risk to the operator, other people or the environment • Carry out routine maintenance on the equipment • Carry out correct procedures for cleaning personal protective equipment and application equipment
